SPECIALTY CLINIC HOST PACKAGE

Specialty Clinics are NOT the same as Certification Clinics. Specialty Clinics are extra-curricular development opportunities for coaches to help them effectively teach and correct skills. These clinics are extremely effective development tools for our coaches and therefore our players. Specialty Clinics are FREE of charge for the participant & host.

These clinics hold no certification value; however Specialty qualifications are added to participants Hockey Canada records, similar to the certification clinic programs. All coaches will receive a full **drill package or DVD** in most clinics we offer; emphasis on skill development and teaching strategies.

SPECIALTY CLINIC MENU:

Host sites can book a single clinic or a “Coaches Day.” The Coaches Day consists of two Specialty Clinics to be delivered in one day. Each clinic is 3 hours and topics can be chosen from:

- Puck Control
- Developing Skilled Defensemen
- Introduction to Skating
- Teaching Body Checking
- Shooting and Scoring
- Small Area Games
- Puck Control
- Coaching Goaltenders
- Starting a Breakfast Club

We can also help coaches with sessions on practice planning as well.

REGISTRATION:

Participants will have two ways to register for Specialty Clinics:

- By email or phone directly with the clinic Host contact person
- Online with the Hockey Canada e-Learning System accessed through the Hockey Manitoba website

Hockey Manitoba & the Host contact will communicate together throughout the registration process to continually update each other on registration numbers.

HOST SITE REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have a minimum of **10 participants** per clinic
- Maximum of 30 participants
- Host must book 1.5 hours of ice time (ice expense covered by the Host)
- Host must book classroom for 1.5 hours (w/ ample tables and chairs, cost covered by Host)
- Host must ensure there is a white wall or projection screen in classroom
- Note: Clinic instructor will bring an LCD Projector and Laptop
- Host to supply ample amount of pucks and pylons for all sessions

- Small Area Games: Host to provide 2 goaltenders for the on-ice component
- Teaching Body Checking: Host to provide 8-12 minor bantams for the on-ice session
- Shooting and Scoring: Host asked to have 4 nets available & 2 goaltenders for on-ice
- Coaching Goaltenders: Host asked to provide 4 goaltenders
