Excluding the Winnipeg Region, each Region within the province of Manitoba has been instructed by Hockey Manitoba to set aside the first weekend in February for selection of players for the Hockey Manitoba Development Programs. Normal game schedules will be altered for players of these age groups (2nd year Peewee, Bantam, Midget) for February 7, 8 and 9, 2010.

As a player born between 1993-1997 you are eligible to participate in one of our development programs. **Please be aware that you are only eligible to participate in the development program that is applicable to your birth year.** All players must try-out for the **region in which they reside** and players must be **registered members** of Hockey Manitoba.

REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT SQUADS TOURNAMENTS

IF YOU ARE A 1997 BORN MALE player you are eligible to participate in the **2010 Regional Development Squads Tournaments**.

This program is designed to bring together all interested rural 2nd year Peewee players, regardless of skill level, to participate in a season ending development opportunity.

Each Region must enter a minimum of two (2) teams in order to participate in the Squads program. It will be each Region's responsibility to determine how teams are to be divided (ie: geographically, etc). Players **MUST** participate in the regional camp within the region they reside in.

This year's Regional Development Squads Tournaments will be held in the Norman, Central Plains and the Eastman Regions on April 9 - 11, 2010.

FEMALE BANTAM CHALLENGE

IF YOU ARE A 1995 OR 1996 BORN FEMALE player you are eligible to participate in the **2010 Female Bantam Challenge Tournament** in Morden, MB, March 26-28, 2010. This tournament is designed to introduce female athletes to the Hockey Manitoba Program of Excellence.

The objective of this program is to provide players the opportunity to compete in a high level sporting event. All players must try out for the Region in which they reside and must be current members of Hockey Manitoba.

DIRECTOR'S CUP U-15 TOURNAMENT

IF YOU ARE A 1996 BORN MALE player you are eligible to participate in the **2010 Director's Cup Tournament**. This development opportunity introduces athletes to the concept of the Hockey Manitoba Program of Excellence.

The objective of the Director's Cup Program is to provide some of the province's skilled players an opportunity to compete amongst their peer group in a high level tournament.

These tournaments consist of entries from Norman, Parkland, Westman South, Brandon, Interlake, Central Plains, Pembina Valley, Yellowhead, Eastman and three teams from Winnipeg.

All players must try out for the Region in which they reside and must be current members of Hockey Canada.

This event is scheduled for April 9-11, 2010, in Morris and Rosenort, MB.
