The *Sr. Coordinator, Coach Development* is responsible for working with the Director, Development and Director, Operations to effectively deliver and advance all aspects of the Coach Certification/Training and Coach Mentorship programs including coach training clinics, coaching and grassroots mentorship, instructor recruitment, training and evaluation, working with minor hockey associations/leagues, coach clinic branding, coach development and monitoring of database deficiencies to ensure that it meets the organizational objectives of Hockey Manitoba.

- Work with Coordinator, Registration and Support Services in the monitoring of Hockey Canada Registry (HCR) database certification an deficiencies for coaching, respect in sport and safety certification
- Communicate with both the Director, Development and Director, Operations on a daily basis and bring forward pertinent issues as they arise
- Assist in outbound communications such as bulletins and action items pertaining to assigned programs. All mass communication will be proof read and approved by senior staff before distribution.
- Assist and support in the delivery of additional branch programming
