How much does Hockey University cost?

The following fees apply for Hockey University (Visa & Mastercard only):

HU – Online Coach 1/2 \$31.00 +GST

HU - Safety \$25.00 +GST

I can't sign up for a coach clinic

Verify that your eHockey profile is link to a member profile. eHockey will not allow you to continue with registration without a profile.

Clinic season is not open for registration until SEPTEMBER 15th, 2017

*You must have completed *HU – Online Coach 1/2 AND completed Respect In Sport prior to registering for an in-person clinic.*

I have my Coach 2 - Coach Level but plan to coach Initiation Level hockey, do I still need Coach 1 - Intro to Coach (Initiation Program)?

Yes! Intro to Coach is developed specifically to learning how to coach within the Initiation program (5-6 yr olds). If you are coaching Novice, either the Coach 1 - Intro to Coach (Initiation Program) or Coach 2 - Coach Level training is sufficient.

I have Speak Out, do I still need Respect In Sport?

Yes. Hockey Manitoba will no longer be accepting the Speak Out Program as of the 2017-18 season.

I took Respect In Sport for another sport, does that still count for Hockey?

*Yes! In order for Respect In Sport (RIS) to be transferred to hockey you must login in to your RIS. On your RIS profile page you need to scroll to the bottom and click the link that says **show access groups**. A menu will drop down listing all the possible sports you can select, at this point you must ADD Hockey as an access group, and be sure to CHECK OFF the appropriate association. Please note you will not be able to register for an in-person clinic until you have completed RIS, and Hockey has been added as an access group.*

Do I need HU - Online Coach 1/2 in order to take Development 1?

No.

How much does my in-person clinic cost?

There is no fee to attend an in-person clinic for either Coach 1 - Intro to Coach or Coach 2 - Coach Level provided that you will be coaching and registered on the team roster for the current season. If you are not coaching this season, you must pay a fee at the end of the season. For Development 1 the fee for the in-person clinic is \$75

Do I get a hard copy binder or skills manual?

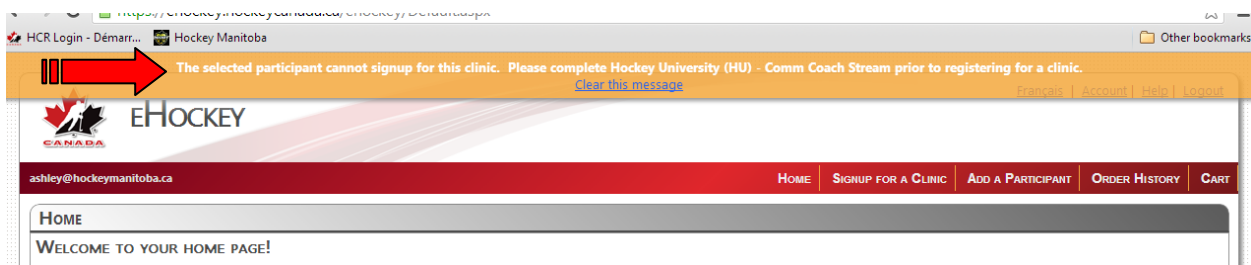

Do I have to wear equipment during my on-ice component of certification?

Yes! It is required that you wear a CSA approved helmet, skates, stick and gloves.

E-hockey won't allow me to register for an in-person clinic. Why?

If you see this message at the top of your screen when you attempt to register for an in-person clinic, you have not completed the requirements indicated below:



*You must have completed the *HU – Online Coach 1/2 AND completed Respect In Sport PRIOR to registering for an in-person clinic.*

BUT I HAVE completed *HU – Online Coach 1/2 AND completed Respect In Sport and E-hockey still won't allow me to register for an in-person clinic. Why?

This could be due to the following:

- 1) *FULL completion of the *HU – Online Coach 1/2 is required, which INCLUDES THE SURVEY AT THE END OF THE COURSE!!!*
- 2) *Hockey is not added as an access group in Respect in Sport (RIS). Please log in to RIS, under PROFILE and ADD hockey as an access group. [Click here to log into RESPECT IN SPORT](#)*
