

U-16 POE COACHING OVERVIEW

1. General Eligibility

- Hockey Manitoba annually selects one (1) Head Coach and two (2) Assistant Coaches for the U-16 POE
- Applicants must be in good standing with Hockey Manitoba & must currently reside in the province of Manitoba
- Ineligible for any position if Head Coach within the U-16 POE over the last two seasons
- Ineligible for Asst. Coach if previously Head Coach or twice (2) Asst. Coach within the U-16 POE
- Canada Games: Only previous Canada Games Head Coaches are ineligible to apply for another Canada Games
 position, otherwise no other exclusions/ineligibility for Canada Games positions, all qualified coaches eligible to
 apply

2. Coaching Experience

- Previous POE experience and results
- Years of experience at AAA and Junior levels
- Personal coaching & development philosophy
- Contribution to Hockey Manitoba programs and the development of minor hockey
- Must have an excellent knowledge and understanding of the POE, high performance tactics, systems and strategy
- Must have a significant coaching experience and background with preference given to those currently coaching in the present hockey season at a level that leads to a Western and/or National championship

3. Professional Development

- Head Coaches must be fully certified with the High Performance 1 Level or better
- Assistant Coaches must be fully certified with a minimum of Development 1 (HP1 preferred)
- Canada Games: Assistant Coaches must be fully certified with High Performance 1 Level or better
- Coaches must be fully certified no later than 60 days prior to the opening of the championship
- Must prove a demonstrated track record of continued personal coaching development
- Head Coach to attend Hockey Canada POE Coach Seminar and National U-17 Development Camp

4. Knowledge of Provincial Team/National Team competitions

- Knowledge of Manitoba style of play and Western/National competition
- Understanding of what is important at each camp phase of the process ie) skills/tactics vs team strategy
- · Ability to recognize and select players that will be successful versus other Provincial Teams
- Strong understanding of the key principles of short-term competition in a high performance setting
- Knowledge & understanding of potential game adjustments with proven ability to facilitate them during competition
- Demonstrated ability to incorporate and support the 4 pillars of the POE (Mental, Physical, Technical, Environment)

5. Human Resources

- Must have the ability to provide leadership, be self-disciplined and self-motivated
- Must be able to work within a group and have excellent communication skills with all players/staff
- Must have the ability to fit within an established Provincial/National program structure
- Must be able to successfully cope with deterrents and hardships in competition and selection process
- Must possess assertive consensus-building and decision making skills
- Must adhere to the guidelines & principles of Hockey Manitoba under the direction of the U-16 POE Director of Operations

6. Knowledge of the Program

- Coaches must be adaptable and deemed suitable to work within our "POE Canadian Way" identity
- Proven ability to work towards the objectives of a high-performance program as opposed to a club team
- Proven ability to maintain the highest standards of personal conduct & program delivery within POE & club levels
- Proven ability to develop players with the age-appropriate skills and individual tactics (Long-term Player Development)
- Proven ability to efficiently introduce, as well as lead, a strong team culture and identity
- Proven interest in selecting the best possible players to form a successful team, regardless of their point of origin
- Proven appreciation of the unique problems that can conceivably occur in the selection or operation of the POE
- Ability to work professionally with various National U-17 program & Western Hockey League personnel
