



2025 IHF World Junior Championship Ultimate 50/50 Rules of Play

1.0 Definitions: In this document capitalized words have the following meanings:

1.1 In these Official Rules (“Rules”), the following capitalized terms have the following meanings, and all other capitalized terms have the meanings ascribed elsewhere in these Official Rules:

“**Draw Number**” means a unique multi-digit of number which represent a single entry in the Prize Draws;

“**Eligible Territory**” is the Province of Manitoba.

Manitoba or HM is the Hockey Canada governing body for amateur hockey in the Province of Manitoba.

“**Participant**” includes a real person who purchases a Ticket, attempts to purchase a Ticket, receives a Ticket, finds a Ticket, or attempts to redeem a Ticket as a winning Ticket to claim a Prize;

“**Prize**” has the meaning set out in Section 6.1;

“**Prize Draws**” is a term encapsulating Raffles;

“**Official Rules**” means this document as may be amended; Hockey

“**Raffle**” means an electronic 50/50 raffle (online) being offered by ~~Hockey~~ **Manitoba or HM** to determine the winner of a Prize;

“**Ticket**” means a document (paper or electronic) which records one or more Draw Numbers in the possession of the Participant which allows the Participant to participate in a Prize Draw;

Official Rules: By purchasing a Ticket or otherwise participating in the Prize Draws, each Participant agrees to these Official Rules. HM reserves the right to make amendments to these Official Rules as necessary, which amendments will become effective upon publication of revised Official Rules at Hockeycanada5050.ca. Any such amendments to the rules must be approved by the LGCA.

~~2.0 **Official Rules:** By purchasing a Ticket or otherwise participating in the Prize Draws, each Participant agrees to be irrevocably bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of HM, which shall be binding and final as to all matters related to each Prize Draw. HM reserves the right to make amendments to these Official Rules as necessary, which amendments will become effective upon publication of revised Official Rules at Hockeycanada5050.ca.~~

3.0 Prize Draws:

3.1 Prize Draws will be conducted by **HM** as follows:

- There will be a total of three Ultimate 50/50 Raffles. Which Raffle a Participant is registered in will depend on the time that they purchased their Ticket, as indicated below:

- **Ultimate 50/50 Draw #1:**
 - For Tickets purchased between Wednesday, December 4th, 2024, at 10:30 AM and Thursday December 26th, 2024, at 11:30-PM
 - **Ultimate 50/50 Draw #2:**
 - For Tickets purchased between Thursday December 26th, 2024, at 11:45 PM and Tuesday December 31st, 2024, at 11:30-PM
 - **Ultimate 50/50 Draw #3:**
 - For Tickets purchased between Tuesday December 31st, 2024, at 11:45 PM and Sunday January 5th, 2025, at 11:30 PM
- The draw for each Raffle will take place at the times indicated below, and will be done electronically:
 - Ultimate 50/50 Draw #1 | Thursday December 26th, 2024, at 11:30 PM
 - Ultimate 50/50 Draw #2 | Tuesday December 31st, 2024, at 11:30 PM
 - Ultimate 50/50 Draw #3 | Sunday January 5th, 2025, at 11:30 PM
 - All times noted above or elsewhere in these Official Rules are in Central Standard Time.
 - Ticket prices are:
 - \$10 for 1 | \$10 per ticket
 - \$25 for 25 | \$1 per ticket
 - \$50 for 100 | \$0.50 per ticket
 - \$100 for 250 | \$0.40 per ticket
 - \$200 for 999 | \$0.20 per ticket

Tickets will be sold using an electronic raffle system supplied by Bump Worldwide Inc.. Tickets will be delivered electronically by way of email.

3.3 Each Ticket is the receipt for the Participant and represents one or more Draw Numbers, each of which is entered into a Prize Draw. Draw Numbers are not eligible for entry into past or future Prize Draws. There is no limit to the number of Draw Numbers an entrant may purchase for a Prize Draw, ~~subject to availability.~~ Tickets are not transferrable. All sales of Tickets are final and refunds shall only be made available where the main Raffle for which the Ticket was purchased is cancelled entirely. Ticket purchases are not donations and are not tax deductible.

4.0 Eligibility: Participants must be legal residents of Manitoba who are eighteen (18) years of age or older and can provide valid government issued identification upon request. Prize Draws are void outside Manitoba and where prohibited by law, rule or regulation. All federal, provincial and local laws and regulations apply.

5.0 Excluded Individuals. No employee, director, officer, member, or volunteer engaged by HM Hockey Canada, the Hockey Canada Foundation, the Bump Worldwide Inc./Canadian Bank Note Company Limited may participate in the Prize Draws or receive a Prize. The immediate family members of the identified persons above living in the same household (i.e., spouse and children) are not eligible to participate in the Prize Draws or receive a Prize.

6.0 Prize:

6.1 For each of the three (3) Raffles, there will be a ~~grand~~ prize which will be one-half (or fifty percent (50%)) of the gross proceeds collected from the sale of the Tickets for that time period, as specific is section 3.1 above (the “Prize”). The remaining one-half (or fifty percent (50%)) of the gross proceeds collected from the sale of Tickets that are not distributed as a Prize will be used to benefit or support the charitable purposes of **HM**.

7.0 Random Drawing: Every transaction is electronically tallied. For each Prize Draw, the potential winner of the Prize will be selected by random number generator. There will be one (1) potential winner chosen for each Prize. If for some unforeseen reason (e.g., weather delay, power outage, emergency, or other reasonably unforeseen event) a Prize Draw is not completed at the scheduled time, the selection of the winning Draw Number will be completed the first business day that normal business operations resume, and a notice of the winning Draw Number will be posted on 50/50 website at Hockeycanada5050.ca

8.0 Winner Notification: The winning Draw Number will be posted online at Hockeycanada5050.ca within forty-eight (48) hours after it has been selected. As per Term 8.06 of LGCA raffle license terms and conditions the winner will be contacted within 10 days using the contact information provided at time of purchase. In the event of a discrepancy between the actual Draw Number drawn and the announced Draw Number, the actual Draw Number drawn will be considered the valid winning ticket.

9.0 Claiming of Prizes:

9.1 All Prizes must be claimed at the following location by the potential winner: By contacting the **Hockey Manitoba Office at 204.925.5757**.

9.2 All winners will have up to ninety (90) days following the conclusion of the applicable Prize Draw date to claim the Prize. The purchased Ticket is the only valid receipt to claim a Prize. The original e-mail confirmation of the Ticket must be presented and reflect the winning Draw Number for the applicable Prize Draw. A photocopy, photograph or reproduction of the e-mail confirmation will not be accepted. A person presenting a winning Ticket will be required to present valid government issued identification confirming that they reside in the Eligible Territory and complete an Affidavit of Eligibility and Release.

9.3 Following verification of eligibility and the completion of all required documentation, **HM** will mail a check to the winner within approximately thirty (30) days of the date of completion of all required paperwork. No cash payments will be made to any winner.

9.4 If the potential winner fails to claim a Prize in the time period above, a new Prize Draw will be held to determine a new winner.

10.0 Publicity Release: Each Prize Draw winner agrees that acceptance of a Prize grants to **HM**, Hockey Canada, and the Hockey Canada Foundation the right to print, publish, broadcast, and use world-wide, in any media now known or later developed at any time or times, such Prize Draw winner's name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, and biographical information for any purpose, including but not limited to in advertisements, publicity, and other communications without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.
