



Regional Development Program (RDP)

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Regional Development Program?

The Regional Development Program provides athletes with additional opportunities to develop their skills and understanding of the game through practice, competition, and other development opportunities.

Who can participate?

The program is available to eligible athletes in the **U11, U13, and U15 age** categories within participating regions.

Is the program gender-specific?

No. The RDP is open to eligible athletes regardless of gender.

Why am I registering through Hockey Manitoba?

As this is a developing program, Hockey Manitoba is using a centralized registration to track participation across regions and monitor the program's growth and success over time.

Which registration should I complete?

Register through the registration for the region you will be participating with and select the appropriate age category.

How much does the program cost?

Program fees are not collected through this registration. Your region will provide information about the applicable fee and payment process at a later date.

What happens after I register?

Once you complete the registration, your information will be shared with the appropriate regional contact for follow-up and program communication.
